New kitchen for Colegio San Andres



These pictures show the existing kitchen in the Colegio. Imagine cooking meals for the pupils every day on this equipment!



Currently the kitchen contains a hob with two rings but no oven, an undersized fridge, little or no work surface areas and one sink for all the dish washing.

Despite this, the ladies cheerfully provide just under 100 meals daily and regularly provide sandwiches for up to 300 people at school functions.



Our help would enable the Colegio to refurbish their kitchen and provide more suitable equipment to help with the necessary food preparation and provision of meals.

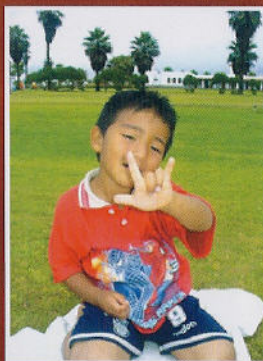
Education for Deaf Children

Our gift will help to provide much needed resources.



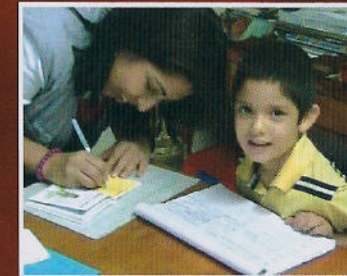
